



Camp Currier Shooting Sports Range & Equipment Reservation Guidelines For Boy Scout and Venture Scout Events

Reservation Procedures & Availability

1. The rifle, archery or shotgun range must be reserved at least two weeks in advance through the Council office.
2. Reservations are for a full day. 8:00 am to the earlier of sunset or 7:00 pm. While units may specify the day, they prefer, the final decision will be based on availability and demand. Large units (30 or more) can reserve two days.
3. The ranges are not available when the entire camp is reserved or closed.

Qualified Supervision Requirement:

RIFLES: For up to eight (8) shooting stations there must be a NRA Range Safety Officer and a NRA Certified Rifle Instructor or BSA NCS Sports Director on the range while shooting. For more than eight (8) shooting stations there must be two (2) NRA Range Safety Officers and two (2) NRA Certified Rifle Instructors or BSA NCS Sports Directors on the range while shooting.

SHOTGUN: For up to six (6) shooting stations there must be a NRA Range Safety Officer and there must also be one (1) NRA Certified Shotgun Instructor or BSA NCS Sports Director for each shooter loading and firing on the range.

PISTOL: (Venture only): For up to three (3) shooting stations there must be a NRA Range Safety Officer and there must also be one (1) NRA Certified Pistol Instructor or BSA NCS Sports Director for each shooter on the range at all times.

ARCHERY: For up to eight (8) shooting stations there must be a USA Archery – Level 1 (basic) or BSA NCS Sports Director on the range while shooting. Action and 3D Archery require a one (1) USA Archery Level -1 Instructor to three (3) shooters ratio.

TOMAHAWK: For up to eight (8) throwing stations there must be a Range Master or Range Safety Officer (RSO).

RANGE SUPERVISION:

Firearms: A certified NRA Range Safety Officer (RSO) is to directly supervise all live fire on the range and must be on the range at all times the guns and ammunition are not properly secured. A currently certified NCS Shooting Sports Director or a NRA certified instructor must conduct the safety briefing. The RSO and the NRA Instructor or BSA NCS Shooting Sports Director must be two separate people. Someone certified as both a RSO and an Instructor cannot fulfill both positions at the same time.

Archery: A certified USA Archery – Level 1 (basic) or higher certification or BSA NCS Shooting Sports Director must be on the range at all times. Use of the trap Archery Range and 3D Archery ranges will require an in-council supplemental training on procedures for the use of that equipment.

Tomahawk: A certified Range Master, RSO, or BSA NCS Shooting Sports Director must be on the range at all times.

This application must show the names and certifications numbers and expiration dates of all required trained personal and copies of certifications for all trained personal must be on file at the Scout Office before authorization will be given to the Camp Ranger to open the ranges or release the requested equipment. Copies of these certifications must also be posted on the range while the range is open.



FIREARM EQUIPMENT: Only Chickasaw Council .22 rifles, .22 pistols and 20 gauge shotguns are allowed at Currier. Boy Scouts are only allowed to shoot bolt action single shot or magazine feed .22 rifles with a minimum trigger pull of three (3) pounds. No tube fed rifles are allowed, Venture and Sea Scouts can also shoot Council .22 caliber pistols at Camp Currier.

ARCHERY EQUIPMENT: The Chickasaw Council has Archery equipment for use. If a unit wished to use its own archery equipment, it must meet the following requirements: Bows will be limited to 40 pounds draw weight and in good working order. Arrows must weigh at least five (5) grains per pound of the bow’s maximum shooting weight. The bows must be inspected and approved by the USA Archery Instructor prior to use. It is the responsibility of the USA Archery Instructor to ensure that these policies are followed. Units may not use crossbows.

SHOOTING SPORTS EQUIPMENT FOR USE OFF SITE: Council shooting sports equipment can be used off site with the approval of the Council Program Director. All rifles, pistols, shotguns, archery, and tomahawk equipment are kept at Camp Currier and it will be the responsibility of the assigned NRA Instructor, NRA RSO or USA Archery Instructor to pick-up and return the equipment to Currier.
