Prerequisites Included:

Basic Instructor Training (BIT) – Must have completed BIT within the last two years
Basic Rifle

BIT – Friday, September 13, 6:00 pm
Basic Rifle– Saturday, September 14, 11:00 am
Rifle Instructor – Sunday September 15. 8:30 am

Course Goals:

To develop NRA Certified Rifle Instructors who possess the knowledge, skill, and attitude essential to organize, conduct, and supervise safe rifle shooting activities for our Scouts. (A Rifle Instructor is required on all BSA rifle ranges.)

Course Requirements:

Must participate in class discussions and demonstrations.
Must score 90% on an open book test.
Must shoot well enough to qualify for the BSA Rifle Shooting merit badge.

Course Fee: Scouters - \$150.00 Payable to the Chickasaw Council.
Non-Scouters - \$250.00 Payable to the Chickasaw Council.
